In a Massachusetts work-related injury, you are allowed to obtain [workers' compensation](#) recovery. However, if your injury was caused by the negligence of another, you may be able to file an additional claim of liability.

## **Construction Accident Third Party Claims**

If you working for a general contractor as a subcontractor and are hurt on the job, you may be able to file two separate claims. In addition of a worker's compensation claim, you may be able to file a liability or negligence claim against the party at fault for your injury. Third party claims often focus on general contractors who failed to follow necessary regulations, creating OSHA violations.

Construction accidents may also involve product and premises liability. In working with a product liability issue, we may call on the knowledge of additional attorneys to assist in handling your claim.
